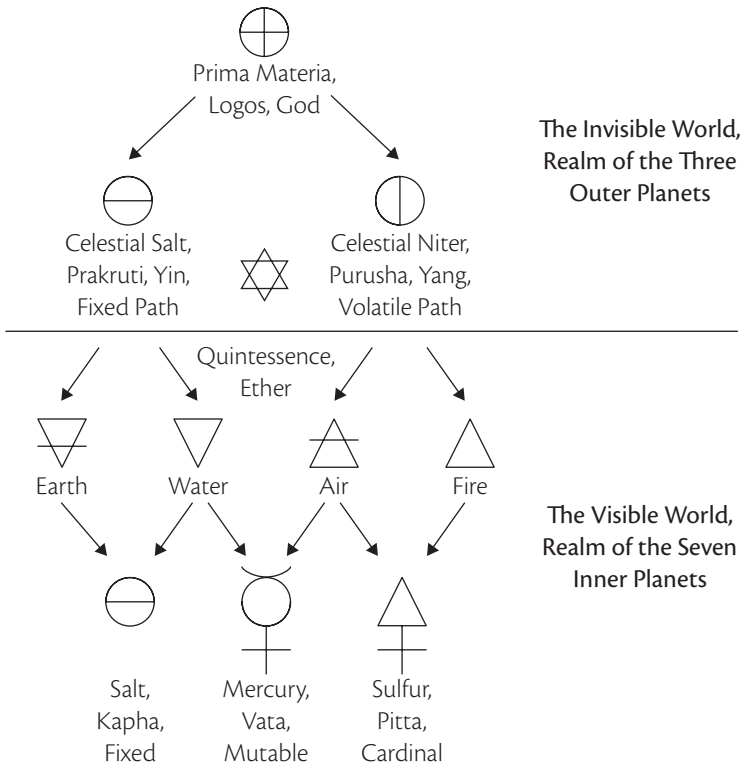


Figure 1. The ten emanations

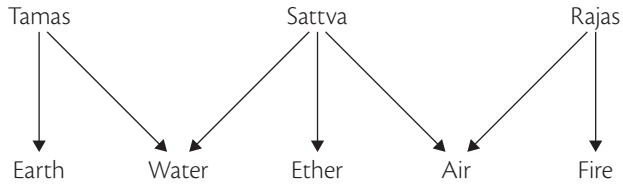


Figure 3. Ayurvedic cosmology of the Elements

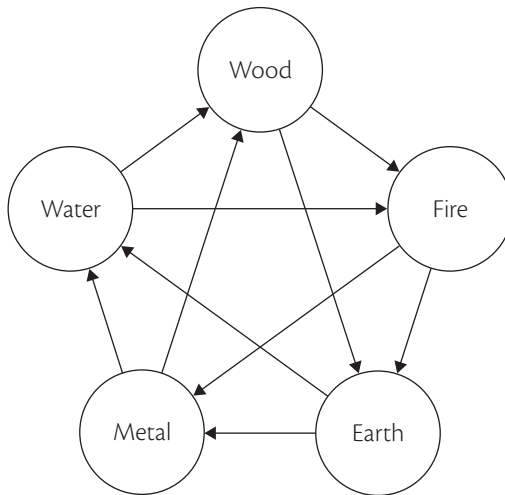


Figure 4. The Chinese Five Elements, or Wu Xing

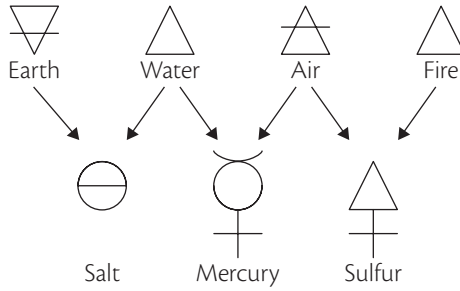


Figure 5. Cosmology of the Three Principles of alchemy

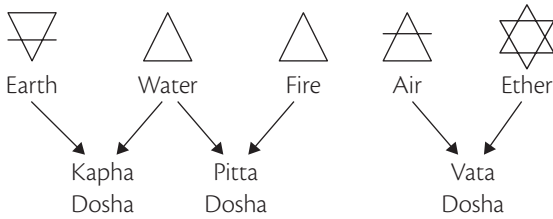


Figure 6. Cosmology of the three doshas of Ayurveda

*Note:* The correspondences between the tastes of herbs and the Planets, Principles, and Elements are based on sympathetic relationships, meaning the tastes are similar to the corresponding facets of energetic architecture. For example, the Three Principles/*doshas* reveal which particular *dosha* will be generally *increased* by an excess of that taste. The Elemental correspondences are the traditional Ayurvedic associations. The Planetary correspondences are taken from my own research. These relationships are not set in stone; rather, they are general patterns. A plant being pungent in taste does not automatically place it under the rulership of the Sun or Mars, though it does help to point us in the right direction. There are always exceptions to any rule. We will further explore the process of determining the energetic architecture of a plant in chapter 17.

Figure 19. The energetic architecture of the six tastes

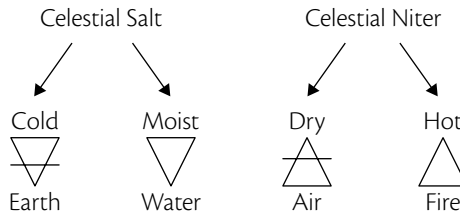


Figure 20. Generation of the four qualities

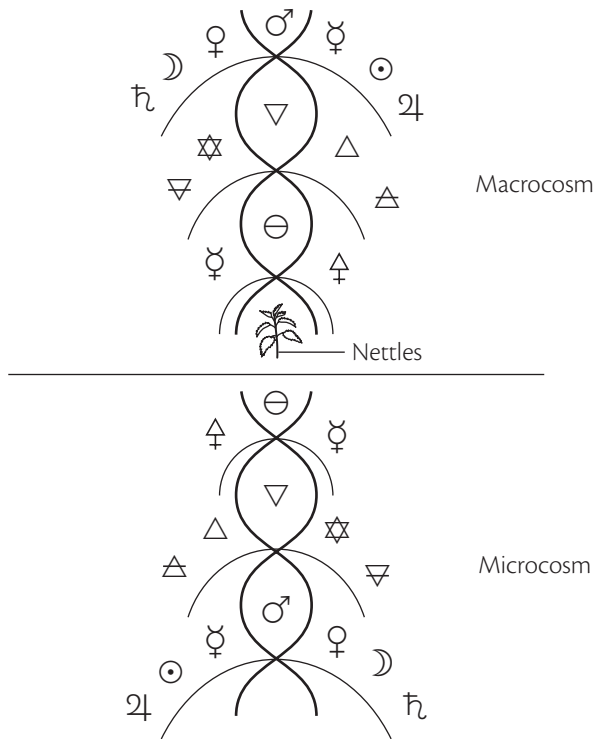


Figure 24. The energetic architecture of Nettles (*Urtica dioica*)

Figure 25. Table of planetary hours

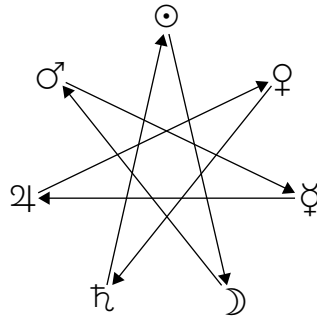


Figure 26. The heptagram, or star of the Magi

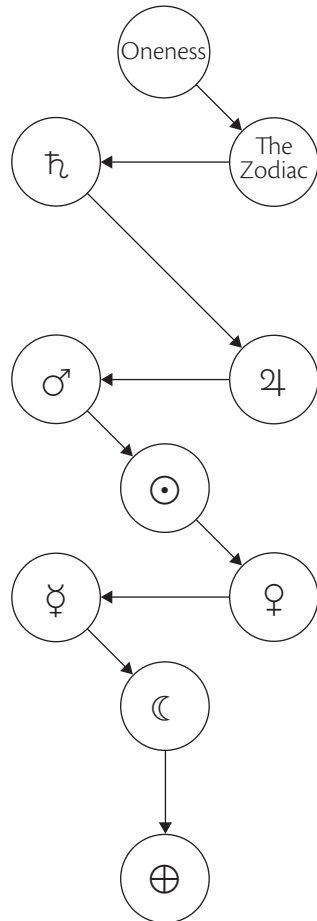


Figure 27. The lightning flash of the Tree of Life

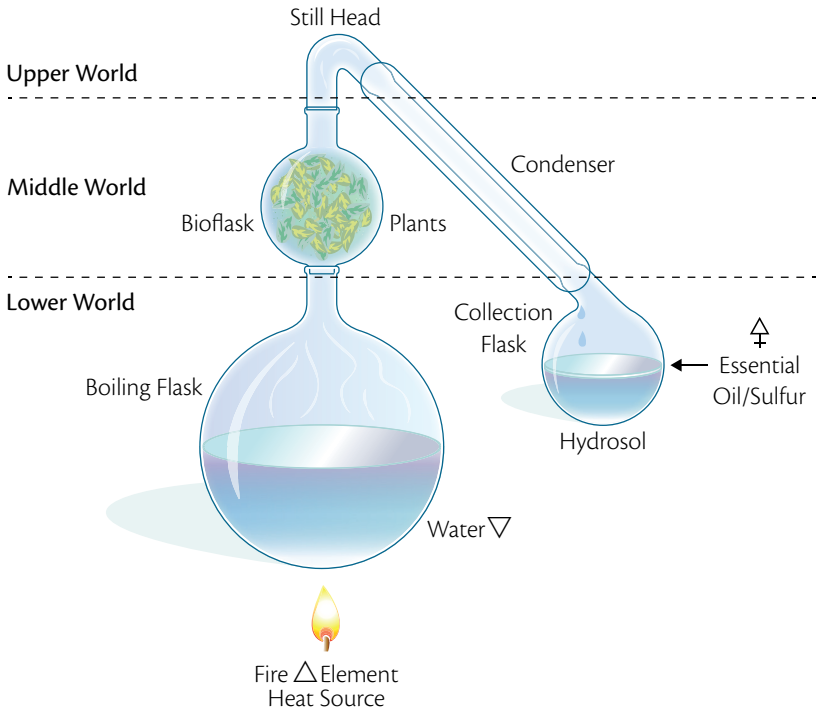


Figure 28. Steam distillation

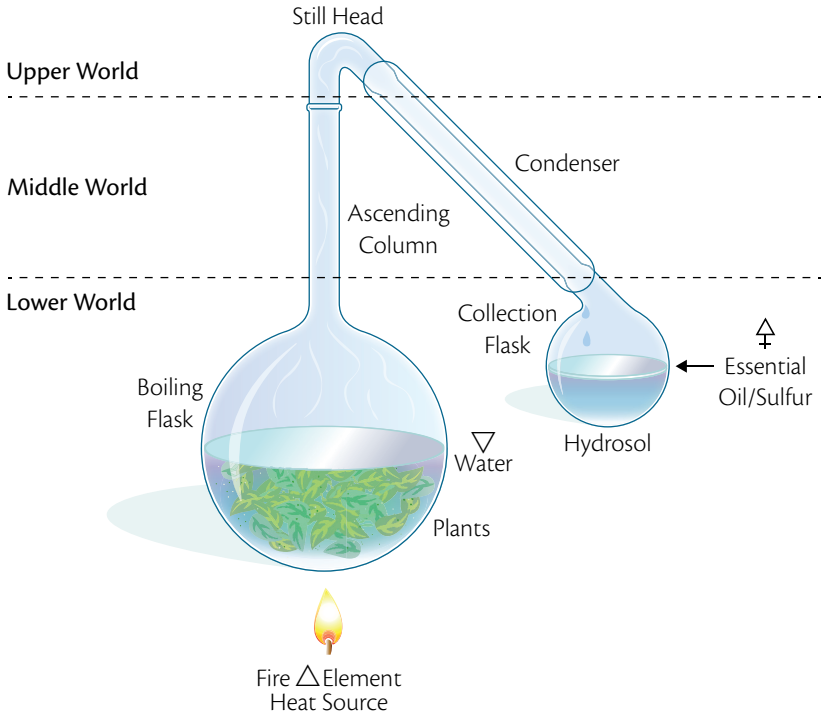


Figure 29. Hydro-Distillation

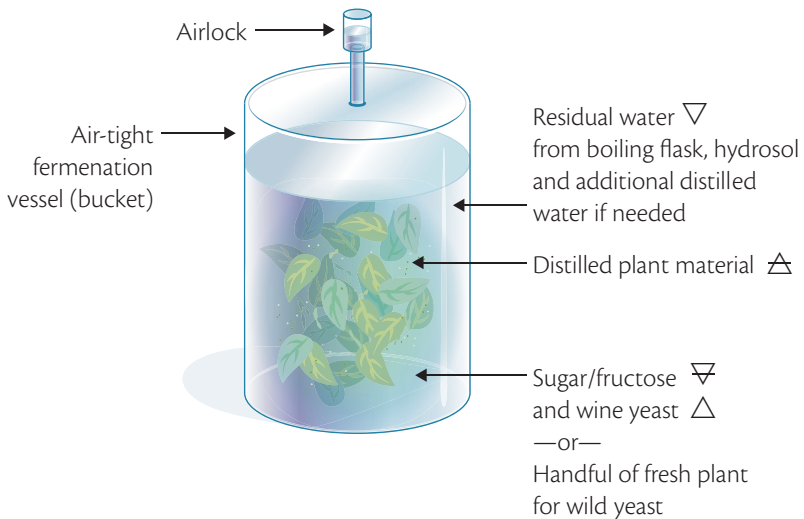


Figure 30. The Elements of fermentation

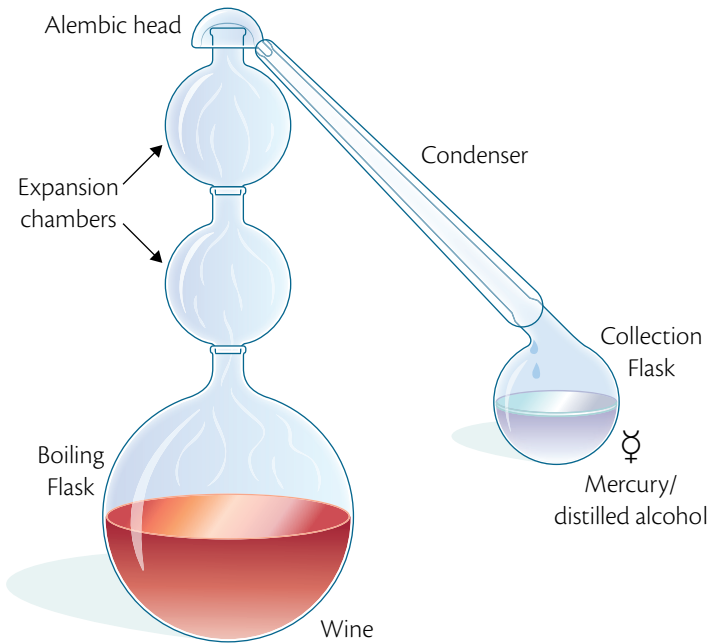
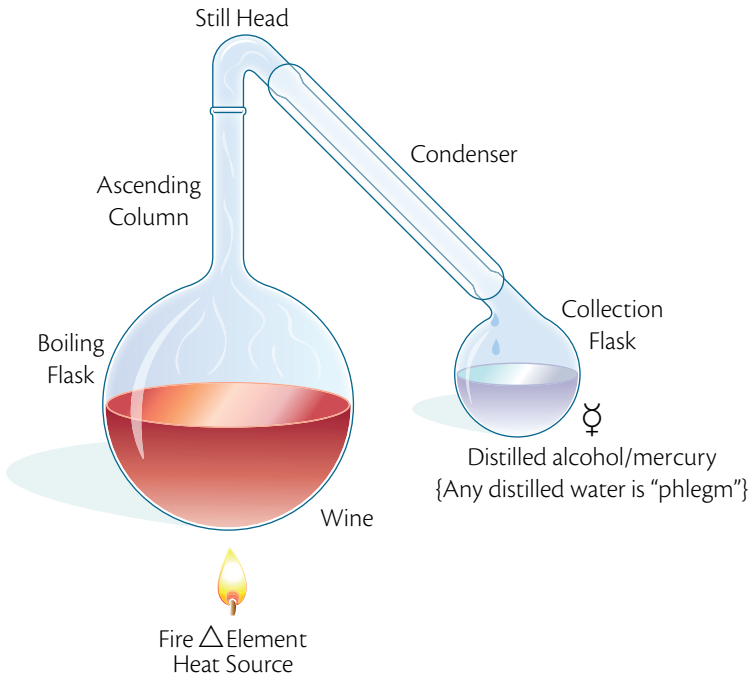


Figure 31. Distillation, or rectification, of Mercury

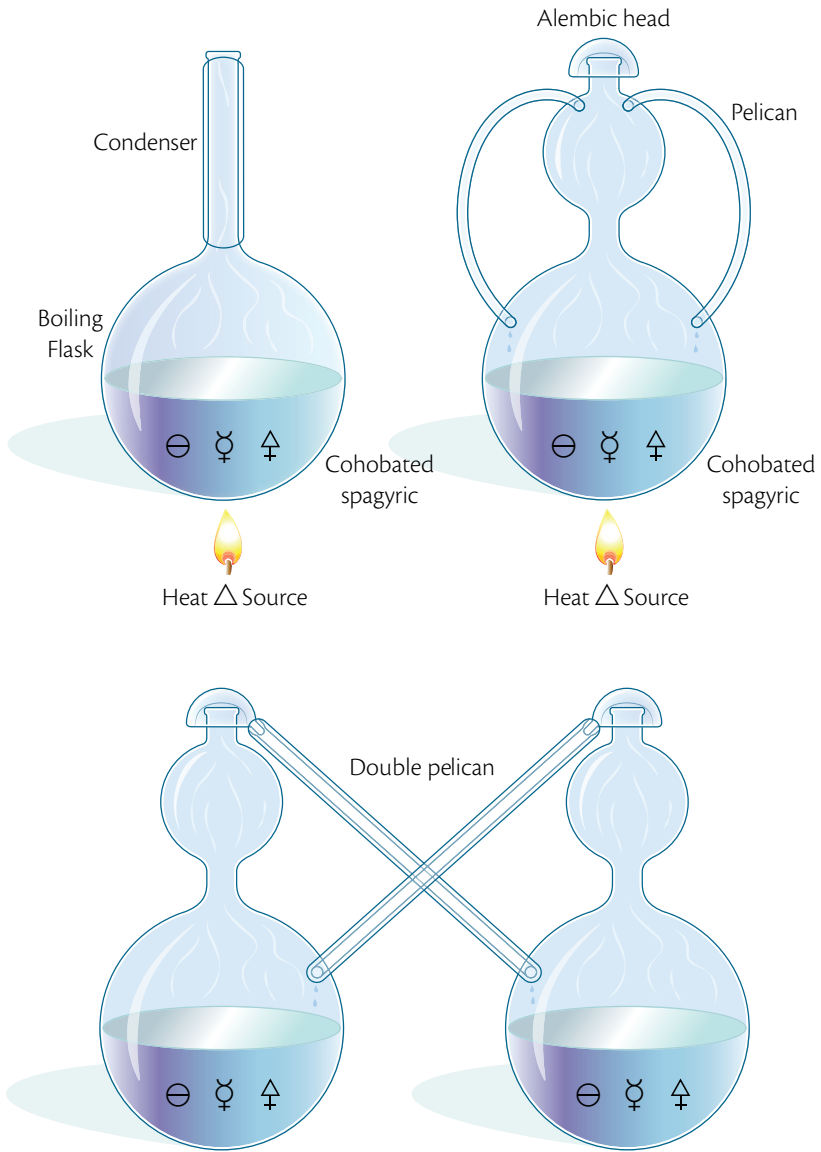


Figure 32. Circulation apparatuses

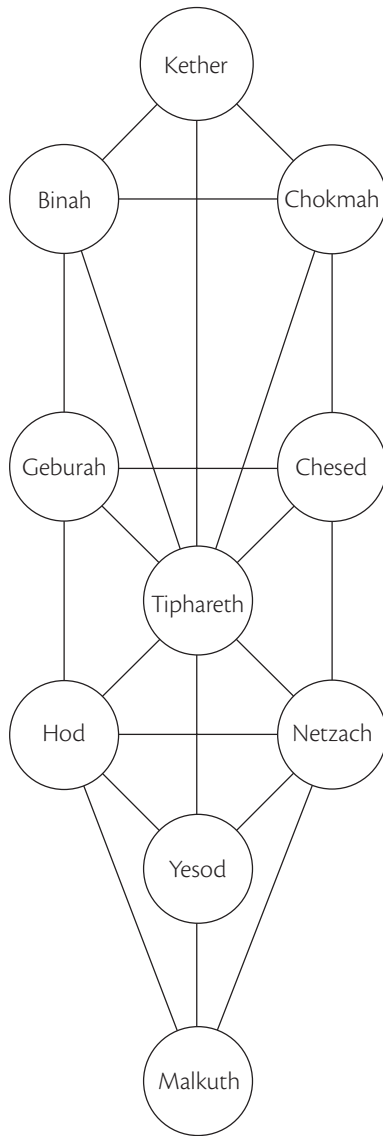


Figure 38. The Qabalistic Tree of Life



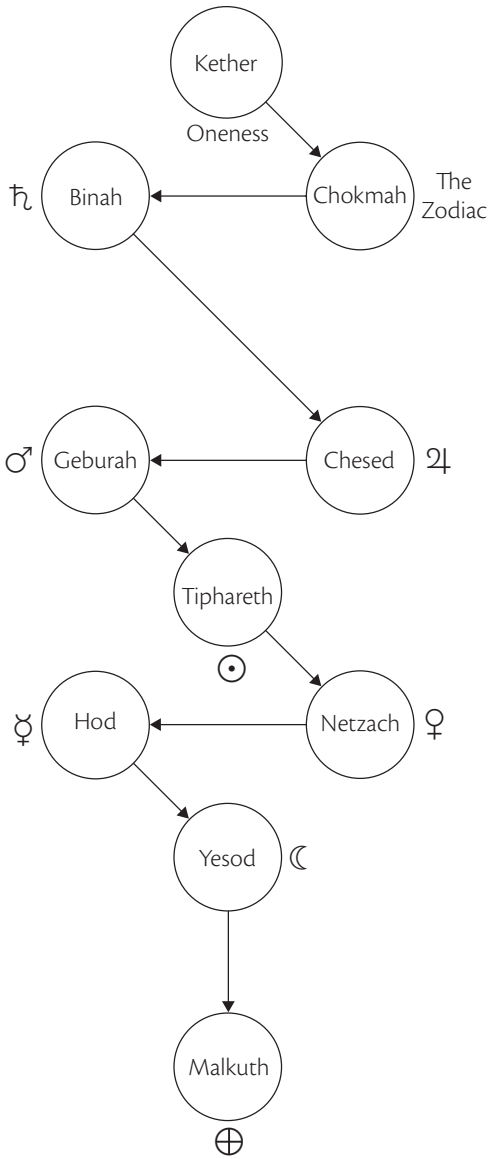


Figure 39. The lightning flash and planetary correspondences

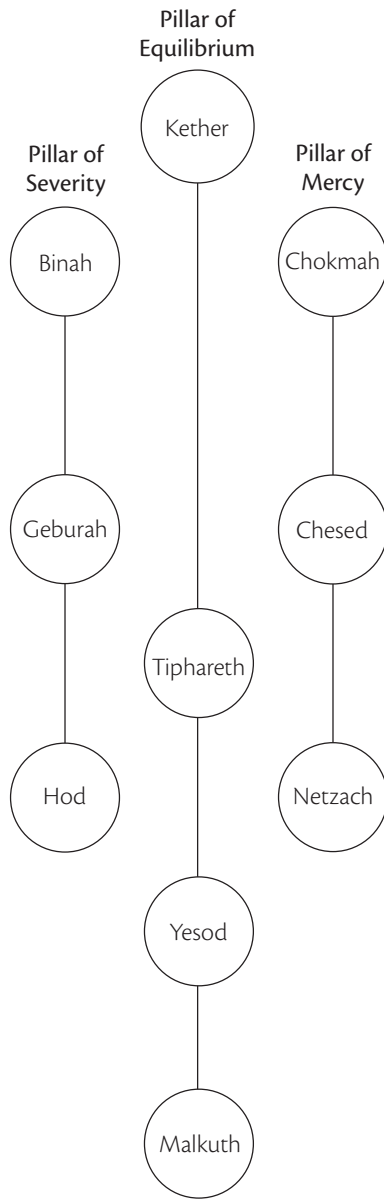


Figure 41. The Pillars of Severity, Mercy, and Equilibrium

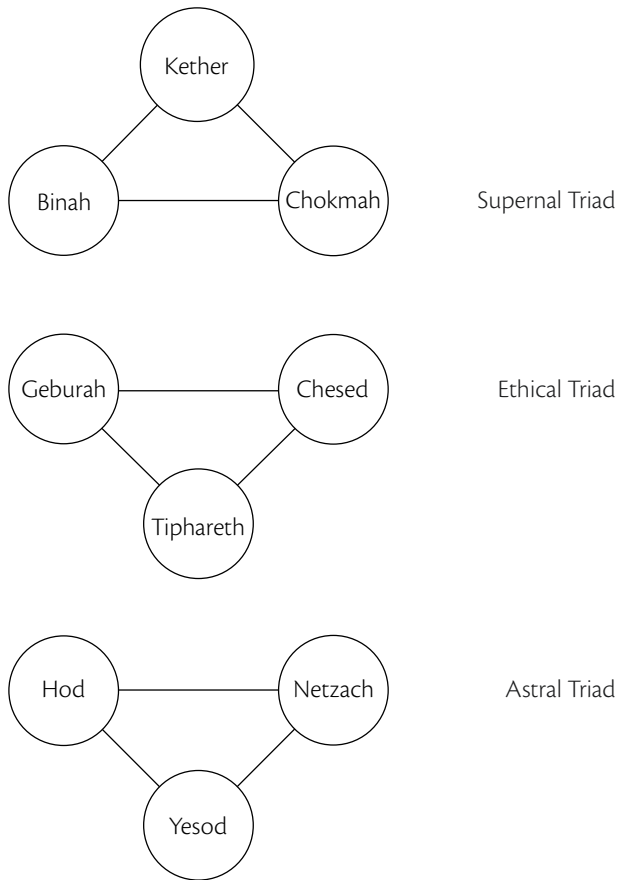


Figure 42. The three triads
