.Com .Net .Gov .Com|Net|Gov



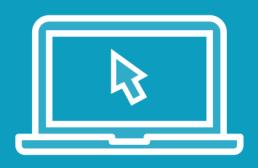
```
'Learning', 'Regex' -match 'Learning|Regex'
(Get-Command) -match '[GS]et-|Add-'
```

Alternation

Are used to match a single regular expression out of several possible expressions. Each possible expression is separated by a vertical bar or pipe symbol.

- Get, Set, and Add

Match PowerShell file extensions

- .ps1, .psd1

Match Windows Event Logs

- Created user events
- Deleted user events
